Project description

Example summary: “Six shade shelters will be purchased and installed above the existing children’s’ playground and three new electric BBQs will be purchased and fitted to a treed area adjacent to the playground. This project will deliver social benefits to our community by improving the quality of the community facilities. The provision of shelter will extend the hours of playtime and provide adults, caregivers and older members of the community with a better environment to participate in outdoor community activity.”
