HIT THE GROUND RUNNING

In the first 100 days the Albanese Government has hit the ground running and demonstrated the approach and the values that will shape our government.

The Labor Government's achievements reflect that approach:

We've successfully submitted to the Fair Work commission for an increase to minimum wage; worked with states and territories on disaster response and COVID; we're getting to work fixing aged care; establishing paid domestic violence leave; advancing reconciliation and an Indigenous Voice to Parliament. We've also passed the first climate change bill in a decade. This legislation will allow emissions to be reduced by at least 43% by 2030.

In the coming sitting weeks, we will be focusing on **Child Care Subsidy reform** and fulfilling our election promise to establish a **Federal integrity body.**

After a decade of waste, delay and neglect, we inherited a range of problems that we got to work on immediately. But governments can't just focus on the problems in front of us at the expense of the long term – we have to do both. In every area we have to tackle immediate and urgent challenges, while also planning ahead to shape the future.


It's always Labor Governments that undertake the big reforms, to create lasting prosperity and a better future.

In Question Time, I was asked about early childcare affordibility.


