Fee-Free TAFE

Enrol today in fee-free TAFE and VET courses!

Cheaper Medicines

The Albanese Labor Government is easing the cost of living, by making medicines cheaper.

Since January 1, Australians have been paying up to 30% less for prescription medicines on the Pharmaceutical Benefit Scheme.

If you are taking one medication a month you will save as much as \$150 every year, and those with two or three medications will save as much as \$300-\$450 a year.

Our changes mean more people can afford to get the medications they need to stay healthy – without worrying so much about the price.
